Our MSc in Maternal Fetal Medicine is a unique programme in Hong Kong that offers a comprehensive curriculum to help physicians, nurses, midwives, and laboratory technicians enhance their professional knowledge in the field of maternal and fetal medicine.

This 24-month part-time programme focuses on both theoretical and practical skills and is designed to equip students with the knowledge and expertise required for the diagnosis, treatment, and management of high-risk pregnancies. For maternal medicine, the programme covers topics related to the diagnosis, treatment, and care of pregnant women with medical conditions / obstetric complications, including hypertensive disorders of pregnancy, cardiac disease, haematological disease. For fetal medicine, it covers the diagnosis and management of a wide range of fetal anomalies, as well as practical skills in ultrasound and fetoscopy and technological advances in fetal intervention.
